1 Sourcing

All products and materials supplied from responsible and ethical sources. All wood based products to be FSC certified or recycled. Materials to be recycled and recyclable. To extend our end of life furniture recycling programme to ensure zero client landfill.

2 Climate Neutral

We are already climate neutral, saving three times as much carbon as we produce via our end of life furniture recycling scheme. However, we continue to work on energy efficiency across all aspects of our business to reduce our usage and business impact.

3 Natural Materials

Use of natural materials and textures from renewable sources to aid Well-being in the workplace alongside fewer chemicals. Also incorporate biophilic principles with natural colour schemes and maximising any natural daylight and introduction of real plants to improve air quality and staff productivity.
